POOL INFO

Competition will take place in a **25-yard pool with 7 lanes**. The competition pool has a depth of 9.5 feet at the start end and 4 feet at the turn end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). A Colorado Timing System with 4-lane electronic timing display will be used with Hy-Tek Meet Manager.

MEET FORMAT & SCHEDULE

All events will be Timed Finals with positive check-in. Positive check-in will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet. Provided consent by all teams involved, the warm-up schedule and start times may be adjusted after the entry deadline to ensure a smooth flowing timeline.

ELIGIBILITY

This is a closed YMCA meet. Per the *Swimming Addendum to the Rules That Govern YMCA Competitive Sports*, a member of a YMCA swim team must have a full-privilege YMCA membership and must be a member in good standing of his/her YMCA for 30 days prior to the first day of a YMCA meet.

This meet is also approved in accordance with USA Swimming/Illinois Swimming rules (Approval # ILS0132-26A). For a swimmer's times to be uploaded into the USA Swimming SWIMS database, they must be currently registered as an athlete member with USA Swimming.

Age as of January 4, 2026, shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet.

MEET RULES

This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Illinois Swimming, Inc. All USA Swimming and ISI rules apply including safety rules, which will be strictly enforced.

Electronic entries must be submitted in a format compatible with Hy-Tek Meet

Manager.

ENTRY LIMIT Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 individual events and 2 relays.

ENTRY FEES A flat fee of \$12.00 per swimmer will be charged for this meet. Make

checks payable to Greater Joliet Area YMCA.

POSITIVE CHECK-

IN

This will be a positive check-in meet. Swimmers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each session or they will be scratched from the

day's events.

BULLPEN A bullpen will be provided for 10 & Unders (Session 1). Heat sheets will

be posted on both the pool deck and in the team area in the gym. All events

and heats will be announced.

SPECIAL NEEDS In accordance with USA Swimming Rules, Articles 105 and 202.2.13, the Meet

Referee has the authority to accommodate athletes with disabilities. It is the responsibility of the coaches or athletes to contact the Meet Referee prior to

competition with specific requests.

ADMISSIONS There will be no admission charge for this meet.

CONCESSIONS A small variety of individual and pre-packaged food and drinks will be available

at concessions, payment accepted via cash or credit.

AWARDS Awards will be given for heat winners.

SCORING This meet will not be scored.

RESULTS Full publication results in PDF format along with Meet Manager backup file and

Team Manager Results file will be posted on the JETS website at

www.jetsyswimteam.org and e-mailed to each team within 24 hours after the

meet. Live results during the meet may be viewed on Meet Mobile.

RACING START CERTIFICATION

Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal quardian to ensure

compliance with this requirement.

IMAGE AUTHORIZATION All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Illinois Swimming and the meet host under

the conditions authored by Illinois and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Illinois

Swimming competition to promote such competitions.

CONDUCT

• All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times.

 Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior,

damage to property, etc.

- Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves.
- In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms, or in areas behind the starting blocks.
- Flash photography is prohibited in the pool area when athletes are on the starting blocks.
- Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

SAFE SPORT & MAAPP

All applicable adults participating or associated with the respective meet to which this information applies, acknowledges that they are an applicable adult, subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. All athletes 18 years of age and older must have completed Athlete Protection Training prior to the entry deadline.

Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. Athletes may remain with their parents while in the gym. Once athletes enter the pool facility, parents will be able to view their child via the two observation rooms or in a partitioned off area ondeck for their swimmer's race.

LOCKER ROOMS

- Locker rooms will be open to athletes, however the facility will be open to YMCA members while the meet is being held so the locker rooms cannot be restricted to athletes only. There are private family locker rooms available as well.
- Parents will be directed to use the bathrooms near the front desk.
- Coaches and officials will be directed to use the bathrooms near the front desk or one of the private family locker rooms.

FACILITY RESTRICTIONS

- All swimmers and spectators must check in at the front entrance of the YMCA upon arrival.
- Pool deck, gym and bullpen rooms will be open only for swim meet participants, staff, volunteers, and spectators. The rest of the facility will be open to the public.
